This is a family camp. We have come here to grow in faith and to give thanks to the Lord for the blessings He has given us.

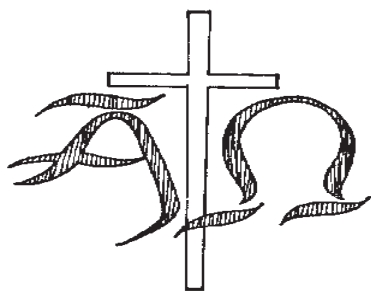
Our conduct here will be pleasing to the Lord. We will be responsible for keeping our areas clean, and leave no mess upon our departure.
