

Comfort/encouragement from Second Corinthians ...

Preaching Another Jesus

It is easy to throw the name "Jesus" around. But is it the Jesus of the New Testament record? The "Jesus" of the Mormons is a "Jesus" who once was a mere human being with a brother named Satan but who was able to attain to the priesthood and have this present earth as his own. The Muslim "Jesus" was a prophet who was taken up to heaven like Elijah and who never went to the cross or was thus resurrected. The "Jesus" of the Roman Catholics is a "Jesus" who reigns as co-regent with a "Mary" who says her heart beats as one with her "son" and who also suffers for mankind's sins. There are a lot of Jesus' out there, but none but One conform to the teaching of the New Testament writings. The apostle Paul

is greatly concerned about the congregation in Corinth because they are willingly accepting twisted teachings. "For if one comes and preaches another Jesus," he says, "whom we have not preached, or you receive a different spirit which you have not received, or a different gospel, which you have not accepted, you bear this beautifully" (2 Corinthians 10:4).

Another Jesus? — The Jesus of the completed revelation is, first of all, the great Yahweh God who took human form, as the apostle Thomas confessed upon seeing Him following His bodily resurrection: "My Lord, and My God!" (John 20:28). He is the focus and fulfillment of Old Testament prophecies. He is the origin and object of the faith of the saints. He is the One born of a virgin, anointed with the Holy Spirit in coming up out of the waters of the Jordan, and who performed signs and wonders among the Jewish people. He is the One who was crucified on Calvary, shedding His blood for the sins of all mankind. He is the One buried in the tomb of a rich man, raised from the dead the third day, and who was seen by witnesses

on earth for forty days. He is the One who ascended to glory, who sits on His eternal throne as High Priest and King. But He is not a Savior whose saving grace can be appropriated by a sprinkling ritual, or by some fake way of salvation, such as "accepting Christ into your heart." He is the Jesus described by Paul in Romans 6: "Or do you not know that all of us who have been immersed into Christ Jesus have been immersed into His death?"

The New Testament writings are replete with warnings about false doctrine.

Any other Jesus, regardless of how close it may seem to the real Jesus of the New Testament writings, is a counterfeit!

- Another Spirit "There is," said the apostle Paul to the brethren in Ephesus, "one Spirit" (Ephesians 4:4). He is the Spirit who hovered over the waters at the Creation, mentioned in the second verse of the Bible. He guided the patriarchs, inspired the Old Testament prophets, rested upon kings like David, led Jesus up into the wilderness to be tempted by the Tempter, gave revelation to the New Testament apostles and prophets, and directed the writing and preservation of the sacred scriptures. While there is much confusion generated by the forces of darkness about the Holy Spirit, the one true Spirit is the One whom a believer receives as the indwelling Spirit at His immersion into Christ. Any other "holy spirit" is a fake!
- Another gospel The true gospel of Christ is that properly proclaims the death, burial, resurrection, appearances, and ascension of Christ. This gospel must not only be believed, but it must also be obeyed, including immersion in Jesus' name for the remission of sins and gift of the indwelling Spirit. Any other "gospel" is a twisted perversion!

The New Testament writings are replete with strident warnings about false teachers, false prophets and false doctrine. Based on how quickly the Corinthian brethren were "bearing beautifully" with twisted teachings, it is clear that the modern saint must continually be on his guard also.
