Question of the week:


When Ahab became king of the northern kingdom and married Jezebel, a princess of Sidon, worship of what god greatly increased in Israel?

Acts Alive ...

The Preparation of Paul

In his second letter to Timothy, Paul spoke of how Jesus Christ brought life and immortality to life through the gospel, “For which,” said he, “I was appointed a preacher and an apostle and a teacher” (II Timothy 1:11). Thus the three stages in Paul’s growth were stated, occurring in this order:

- Teacher
- Preacher
- Apostle of Jesus Christ

After meeting Jesus on the Damascus road, and being immersed into Christ by Ananias, Paul [who was at first known as Saul] was

primarily a *teacher* of the word. In his letter to the Galatians, he informs us that he received his information by revelation, and that he was set apart from his mother’s womb eventually to preach the gospel to the Gentiles. “I went away to Arabia,” he informs us, “and returned once more to Damascus. Then three years later I went up to Jerusalem to become acquainted with Cephas [Peter], and stayed with him fifteen days... Then I went into the regions of Syria and Cilicia” (Galatians 1:17- 21). It was from Tarsus in Cilicia that Barnabas brought Saul to Antioch of Syria.

“Now there were at Antioch, in the church that was there, prophets and teachers: Barnabas... and Saul. And while they were ministering to the Lord and fasting, the Holy Spirit said, ‘Set apart for Me Barnabas and Saul for the work to which I have called them.’ Then, when they had fasted and prayed and laid their hands on them, they sent them away” (Acts 13:1-3). With the laying on of the hands of the leadership of the congregation at Antioch, both Barnabas and Saul were set aside. From the perspective of the congregation, these two men are *apostles of the church* at Antioch and referred to as such a bit later in Acts. However, from the perspective of the people to whom they are delivering the gospel message, they are *preachers or evangelists*. So Saul is now not only a teacher, but he has been given the office of preacher, as he mentioned in 2 Timothy.

The final step of Saul’s progression was accomplished on the island of Cyprus, a bit west from Antioch’s coast in the Mediterranean Sea. After preaching the word in the synagogues beginning on the east side of the island, they reached the city of Paphos on the western edge. Here Barnabas and Saul were delivering the word to the proconsul, a man named Sergius Paulus, whom the scripture describes as “a man of intelligence” (Acts 13:7). A Jewish false prophet kept opposing them, trying to turn the proconsul away from the faith. At that point Saul was filled with the Holy Spirit, and said, “You who are full of all deceit and fraud, you son of the devil, you enemy of all righteousness, will you not cease to make crooked the straight ways of the Lord? And now, behold, the hand of the Lord is upon you, and you will be blind and not see the sun for a time” (Acts 13:9- 11).

The record shows that this false prophet named “Bar-Jesus” (who was also known as “Elymas the magician”) was immediately enveloped by a mist and a darkness, and went about looking for someone to lead him by the hand. This is the first miracle of Saul, and he is now being moved by the Lord to the next step in his progression, to that of apostle of Christ. Luke notes the significance of the event by recording the name change from “Saul” to “Paul.” From this point, he is able to establish his credentials, as he later detailed to the brethren in Corinth: “The signs of a true apostle were performed among you” (2 Corinthians 12:12).

After being filled with the Holy Spirit, Saul the preacher is then known as *Paul an apostle of Jesus Christ*. The preparation of Paul was complete, and this apostle to the Gentiles is now ready to broadcast the word powerfully into western Asia and Europe. The word moves on!
