



The Epistles to the Evangelists

Just as Jannes and Jambres...

Difficult times are coming, and modern saints must spiritually prepare. The darkness is on a rampage, pushing against the light as hard as possible. As the "de-Christianizing" of America continues, and Western Civilization in general collapses, the "brutal," "treacherous," and other undesirables will become bolder in their denigration of and persecution of anything resembling Christianity. Some of these enemies are openly hostile and try to destroy Christians and Christianity on a person-to-person basis, and others try to destroy Christianity through government oppression. But some are more subtle, and dress themselves in "sheep's clothing." The apostle Paul, in his second recorded letter to Timothy, puts some extra emphasis on these enemies; the brutal ones are obvious, but the subtle ones require

extra alertness and sensitivity.

- Holding to a form of godliness After speaking of the general callousness of the unbelieving world, and describing some as "lovers of pleasure rather than lovers of God, the apostle then focuses on those who are "holding to a form of godliness, although they have denied its power" (2 Timothy 3:5). Those who attend denominational assemblies could be described this way, as well as many who attend congregations making a claim to restoring first century Christianity. True "godliness" has real spiritual power to be involved in saving souls and helping the new creation transformation process to occur. But for those who are interested in the show and the sham, like the Pharisees of Jesus' day they are whitewashed tombs, appearing righteous but full of rottenness and corruption within. The apostle says, "avoid such men as these"!
- Captivating weak women A man with an outwardly righteous exterior, and who
 exhibits attractive charisma, can position himself to comb through the ladies in the
 churches wherein he has influence. "For among them," the apostle says of such men,
 - "are those who enter into households and captivate weak women weighed down with sins, led on by various impulses" (2 Timothy 3:6). Jesus said, "He who comes to Me shall not hunger, and he who believes in Me shall never thirst," and a woman who thus follows the Lord will not be looking for some earthly relationship in order to be fulfilled. (John 6:35). But if a weak woman has not really committed herself to true spiritual growth and true fellowship with Christ, she is still "weighed down with sins,"

and, with an empty searching soul looking in the wrong places, she is easy prey for these smooth-talking womanizers. Described as "led on by various impulses," she often is in the assemblies, eyes wide open but really not hearing and processing what she should. The apostle further comments that she is one of those "always learning and never able to come to the knowledge of the truth" (2 Timothy 3:7). Her personal resistance to the work involved in her changing for the better blocks her from processing scriptural truth.

Opposing truth – In the days of Moses, the magicians performed some pretty powerful miracles in a weak imitation of Moses to turn Pharaoh's heart away from the demands of Moses, the servant of God. The indication is that these magicians' names were Jannes and Jambres, and they are used as examples of those corrupt individuals who hold to the form of godliness and yet are creeping into the houses of weak women. "And just as Jannes and Jambres opposed Moses," avers the inspired apostle, "so these men also oppose the truth, men of depraved mind, rejected as regards the faith" (2 Timothy 3:8). The names on the church membership ledger are not necessarily the same as the names in the Lamb's book of life!

"Men of depraved mind," the apostle terms them. Sooner or later, such sowing to the flesh will yield the harvest of spiritual destruction. "But they will not make further progress," affirms Paul, "for their folly will be obvious to all, as also that of those two came to be" (2 Timothy 3:9). It is not likely that Pharaoh would have gone into battle with Israel without his magicians; it is implicit that Jannes and Jambres perished with the other Egyptians. The absolute folly of following Satan will be evident on Judgment Day. Modern saints will take heed.
