“What then?” - Apostle Paul to the Romans

## Unrighteousness of Men

“The righteousness of God is revealed,” Paul affirmed, adding “from faith to faith.” From the basic faith of Abraham to the more informed faith of David to a modern possessor of “the faith of Christ,” the righteousness of God is revealed, and through that faith God’s righteousness is also granted to the believer. Abraham would not worship the idols of his family north of the Euphrates, so God called him, and began revealing Himself to him. David was recognized as a man after God’s own heart (Acts 13:22), so God had him anointed as king of Israel, caused His Spirit to rest upon him, and gave him prophetic abilities wherein he revealed more of God’s character. The modern saint, most truly as one of those “upon

whom the ends of the ages have come,” (1 Corinthians 10:11), has the maximum information about the righteousness of God revealed to him in written form, and he is therefore justified in his obedience of faith. Whether a person’s background is Jew or Gentile, whether the person is male or female, whether the person is slave or free, the righteousness of God is apprehensible through the common faith of Christ. God has done much to make that revelation possible and available. Amen!

- **Wrath of God** – Not only is the righteousness of God revealed, but His anger toward those who disregard His kindly overtures is also exhibited. The apostle Paul writes, “For the wrath of God is revealed from heaven against all ungodliness and unrighteousness of men” (Romans 1:18). One sin is enough to place the mentally capable individual outside of fellowship with God. “Your iniquities have made a separation between you and your God,” emphasized the prophet, “and your sins have hidden His face from you, so that He does not hear” (Isaiah 59:2). The righteousness of God is such that He cannot countenance sin, sin that spread to man as an extension of the rebellion of the tempter. Consequently, His wrath is “revealed from heaven” so that man might make an informed decision about his eternity. The apostle Paul did his part in announcing to the frequenters of Mars Hill the terms: “God is now declaring to men that all everywhere should repent, because He has fixed a day in which He will judge the world in righteousness through a Man whom He has appointed, having furnished proof to all men by raising Him from the dead” (Acts 17:30,31). “Proof” of the coming Day of Judgment... Will it be heaven, or will it be hell, for all eternity? Each one chooses, by intent or neglect.
- **Suppression of truth** – The descendants of Noah who began to populate Mesopotamia were certainly aware of God’s judgment against unrighteousness, and the echoes of that knowledge even show up in various “Flood traditions” throughout the cultures across the world today. So what is mankind’s general response to the knowledge of God’s righteous judgment? They “suppress the truth in unrighteousness.” Hence it is that those who expound the truth about God have always been suppressed; every attempt has been made to shut their mouths. “Blessed are you,” averred Jesus the Christ, “when men hate you, and ostracize you, and cast insults at you, and spurn your name as evil, for the sake of the Son of Man” (Luke 6:22). That, He said, is “the same way their fathers used to treat the prophets” (Luke 6:23). Satan has thus used tribal structures, kingships, dictatorships, new world order entities, and religious movements to suppress the truth in unrighteousness.

But could they somehow not know? Their participation in suppression of the truth is in one way or another deliberate, “because,” insists the apostle, “that which is known about God is evident within them; for God made it evident to them” (Romans 1:19). They know, and they try to shove the truth about God into a dark cave and never let it out. Against them the wrath of God is rightfully revealed from heaven.!
